HOUSE BILL NO. 5348

January 16, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Garza, Cambensy, Hall and Wendzel and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

by amending section 502 (MCL 436.1502), as added by 2017 PA 129.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 502. (1) Subject to subsection (3), the commission shall issue a salesperson license to an individual who is a designated employee of any of the following persons:
 - (a) A manufacturer of beer.
- 5 (b) A manufacturer of wine.

- 2 (d) An outstate seller of beer.
- 3 (e) An outstate seller of wine.
- 4 (f) An outstate seller of mixed spirit drink.

- 6 (h) A broker that represents 1 or more persons described in7 subdivisions (a) to (g).
- 8 (i) A broker described in subdivision (h) that also represents9 1 or more of the following persons:
- 10 (i) A vendor of spirits.
- 11 (ii) A manufacturer of spirits.
- 12 (i) A vendor of spirits.
- 13 (k) A manufacturer of spirits.
- 14 (1) A broker that represents only 1 or more of the following:
- 15 (i) A vendor of spirits.
- 16 (ii) A manufacturer of spirits.
- 17 (2) A salesperson license issued under this section after the
- 18 effective date of the amendatory act that added this section April
- 19 15, 2018 but before April 30, 2020 expires on April 30, 2020. A
- 20 salesperson license issued under this section is renewable every 3
- 21 years with the first triennial renewal cycle beginning May 1, 2020.
- 22 The commission may charge a reasonable initial license fee and
- 23 triennial renewal fee. The commission shall establish a fee under
- 24 this section by written order. The nonrefundable inspection fee
- 25 under section 529(4) is not required for an application for a new
- 26 salesperson license or transfer of a salesperson license. A
- 27 salesperson license issued or renewed under R 436.1853 of the
- 28 Michigan Administrative Code expires on the earlier of the

- 1 (a) Three years after the date of the issuance or renewal.

- 3 (3) The commission shall not impose any other requirement or 4 consider any other factor beyond the accreditation required in this section for issuance or renewal of a salesperson license. Except as 5 6 otherwise provided in this subsection, the commission shall not 7 issue a salesperson license under this section unless the applicant 8 submits with his or her application written documentation that the 9 applicant has successfully completed a salesperson accreditation 10 program. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the 11 commission shall not renew a salesperson license issued under this 12 section or under R 436.1853 of the Michigan Administrative Code 13 unless the licensee submits with his or her application proof 14 acceptable to the commission that the licensee has successfully 15 completed a salesperson accreditation program no more than 120 days 16 before the date the licensee submits his or her renewal 17 application. An applicant's completion of a salesperson accreditation program is not a condition for issuance or renewal of 18
 - a salesperson license for any of the following applicants:

 (a) A designated employee of a manufacturer of spirits.
- 21 (b) A designated employee of a vendor of spirits.
- 22 (c) A designated employee of a broker described in subsection 23 (1) (l) .
- (4) Except as provided in subsection (5), an individual shall not sell, deliver, promote, or otherwise assist in the sale of alcoholic liquor in any manner to a retailer in this state unless licensed under this section or under R 436.1853 of the Michigan Administrative Code. An individual licensed as a salesperson under R 436.1853 of the Michigan Administrative Code before the effective

- (e) "Salesperson accreditation program" means a program thatthe commission approves under subsection (6) and that is offered by
