A bill to amend 1893 PA 206, entitled "The general property tax act,"

(MCL 211.1 to 211.155) by adding section 78t.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 78t. Notwithstanding any provision of this act to the contrary, if the governor has, for the entire state, declared a state of disaster or state of emergency under both the emergency management act, 1976 PA 390, MCL 30.401 to 30.421, and 1945 PA 302, MCL 10.31 to 10.33, both of the following apply:
 - (a) A foreclosing governmental unit may temporarily suspend

- 1 strict compliance with section 78g(3) and extend the deadline by
- 2 which property forfeited to the county treasurer must be redeemed
- 3 until as late as 30 days after the termination of the state of
- 4 disaster or state of emergency.
- 5 (b) Upon the motion of a foreclosing governmental unit made
- 6 during a deadline extension under subdivision (a), a court may, in
- 7 a manner consistent with the deadline extension, amend orders of
- 8 foreclosure that it issued under section 78k(5) while conditions
- 9 leading up to the governor's declaration existed or while the
- 10 governor's declaration was in effect.
