## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5756**

April 30, 2020, Introduced by Rep. Mueller and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 222, entitled

"An act to provide for an official personal identification card; to provide for its form, issuance and use; to regulate the use and disclosure of information obtained from the card; to prescribe the powers and duties of the secretary of state; to prescribe fees; to prescribe certain penalties for violations; and to provide an appropriation for certain purposes,"

(MCL 28.291 to 28.300) by adding section 2a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2a. (1) The secretary of state may extend the deadline
- 2 for the renewal of an individual's official state personal





- 1 identification card and may waive the penalty for the late renewal
- 2 of an individual's official state personal identification card if
- 3 both of the following apply:
- 4 (a) The governor issued an executive order declaring a state
- 5 of disaster or a state of emergency under the emergency management
- 6 act, 1976 PA 390, MCL 30.401 to 30.421.
- 7 (b) The individual's official state personal identification
- 8 card expired during the period of the state of disaster or the
- 9 state of emergency.
- 10 (2) If the secretary of state extends the deadline for the
- 11 renewal of an individual's official state personal identification
- 12 card under subsection (1), it may provide that the official state
- 13 personal identification card is valid for 60 days after the
- 14 termination of the state of disaster or the state of emergency.
- 15 (3) The secretary of state may waive the penalty for the late
- 16 renewal of the official state personal identification card if both
- 17 of the following apply:
- 18 (a) An individual's official state personal identification
- 19 card expired 1 week before the governor declared a state of
- 20 disaster or a state of emergency under the emergency management
- 21 act, 1976 PA 390, MCL 30.401 to 30.421.
- 22 (b) The secretary of state closed its branches before the
- 23 governor declared the state of disaster or state of emergency under
- 24 the emergency management act, 1976 PA 390, MCL 30.401 to 30.421.
- 25 (4) This section does not apply if an individual's official
- 26 state personal identification card was canceled or forfeited before
- 27 the state of disaster or the state of emergency.
- 28 (5) As used in this section:
- 29 (a) "State of disaster" means that term as defined in section
