## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5765**

May 05, 2020, Introduced by Rep. Warren and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 220, entitled "Persons with disabilities civil rights act,"

by amending section 302 (MCL 37.1302), as amended by 1998 PA 20.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 302. (1) Except where permitted by law, a person shall 2 not do any of the following:
- 3 (a) Deny an individual the full and equal enjoyment of the
- 4 goods, services, facilities, privileges, advantages, and
- 5 accommodations of a place of public accommodation or public service
- 6 because of a disability that is unrelated to the individual's





- 1 ability to utilize and benefit from the goods, services,
- 2 facilities, privileges, advantages, or accommodations or because of
- 3 the use by an individual of adaptive devices or aids.
- 4 (b) Print, circulate, post, mail, or otherwise cause to be
- 5 published a statement, advertisement, or sign which indicates that
- 6 the full and equal enjoyment of the goods, services, facilities,
- 7 privileges, advantages, and accommodations of a place of public
- 8 accommodation or public service will be refused, withheld from, or
- 9 denied an individual because of a disability that is unrelated to
- 10 the individual's ability to utilize and benefit from the goods,
- 11 services, facilities, privileges, advantages, or accommodations or
- 12 because of the use by an individual of adaptive devices or aids, or
- 13 that an individual's patronage of or presence at a place of public
- 14 accommodation is objectionable, unwelcome, unacceptable, or
- 15 undesirable because of a disability that is unrelated to the
- 16 individual's ability to utilize and benefit from the goods,
- 17 services, facilities, privileges, advantages, or accommodations or
- 18 because of the use by an individual of adaptive devices or aids.
- 19 (2) The duties described in subsection (1) remain in effect at
- 20 all times, including during a public health emergency, and under no
- 21 circumstances may a person subject to this article deny an
- 22 individual medical treatment on the basis of stereotypes,
- 23 assessments of quality of life, or judgments about the individual's
- 24 relative "worth" based on the presence or absence of any
- 25 disability. Decisions by a person subject to this article
- 26 concerning whether an individual is a candidate for medical
- 27 treatment must be based on an individualized assessment of the
- 28 individual based on the best available objective medical evidence.
- 29 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act is intended to clarify

- 1 the scope of article 3 of the persons with disabilities civil
- 2 rights act, 1976 PA 220, MCL 37.1301 to 37.1303, during times of
- 3 public health emergencies and to ensure that in times of public
- 4 health emergencies the full and equal enjoyment of the goods,
- 5 services, facilities, privileges, advantages, and accommodations of
- 6 a health facility described in section 301 of the persons with
- 7 disabilities civil rights act, 1976 PA 220, MCL 37.1301, are not
- 8 denied to an individual because he or she is disabled.
