A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 227 (MCL 750.227), as amended by 1986 PA 8.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 227. (1) A—Except as otherwise provided in this
 subsection, a person shall not carry a dagger, dirk, stiletto, a

- 12 person shall not carry a pistol concealed on or about his or her

- 1 (ii) Concealed pistol license applications are not being 2 processed under section 5b or 5l of 1927 PA 372, MCL 28.425b and 28.425l.
- 4 (3) A person who violates this section is guilty of a felony,
 5 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 5 years or by a fine
 6 of not more than \$2,500.00.
