- 1 Sec. 472a. (1) The Except as otherwise provided in subsection
- 2 (2), the signature on a petition that proposes an amendment to the
- 3 constitution or is to initiate legislation shall must not be
- 4 counted if the signature was made more than 180 days before the





- 1 petition is filed with the office of the secretary of state.
- 2 (2) If the governor declares a state of emergency, the 180-day
- 3 time limit for petition signatures to be counted in subsection (1)
- 4 must be extended and the extension must equal the total number of
- 5 days that the declared state of emergency exists.
