## **HOUSE BILL NO. 6002**

July 23, 2020, Introduced by Rep. Garza and referred to the Committee on Families, Children, and Seniors.

A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled "The social welfare act,"

(MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 72.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 72. (1) The department shall establish and administer a disaster relief program for undocumented individuals relating to a state of emergency declared regarding the COVID-19 virus.
- 4 (2) To be eligible for the disaster relief program created in subsection (1), an undocumented individual must provide





- 1 documentation of the following:
- 2 (a) He or she is an undocumented individual 18 years or older.
- 3 (b) He or she is ineligible to receive assistance from funds
- 4 provided by the coronavirus aid, relief, and economic security act,
- 5 Public Law 116-136, other federal assistance related to the COVID-
- 6 19 virus, or other pandemic unemployment benefits due to his or her
- 7 undocumented status.
- 8 (c) He or she has experienced a hardship due to the COVID-19
- 9 virus.
- 10 (3) The department may contract with a third-party
- 11 organization that provides services to immigrants to help
- 12 undocumented individuals apply for assistance under the program
- 13 established in subsection (1).
- 14 (4) An undocumented individual who qualifies for the program
- 15 described in subsection (1) may receive a 1-time payment of \$500.00
- 16 per individual, but no more than \$1,000.00 per household.
