THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 6. (Partnership defined).
- 2 (1) A partnership is an association of 2 or more persons,
- 3 which may consist of husband and wife, spouses, to carry on as co-
- 4 owners a business for profit; any partnership heretofore
- 5 established consisting of husband and wife spouses only, formed





- 1 since January 10, 1942 shall constitute a valid partnership.
- 2 (2) But any association formed under any other statute of this state, or any statute adopted by authority, other than the authority of this state, is not a partnership under this act, unless such that association would have been a partnership in this state prior to the adoption of this act; but this act shall apply applies to limited partnerships except in so far as the statutes relating to such those limited partnerships are inconsistent
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect unless Senate Joint Resolution ____ or House Joint Resolution T (request no. 02690'19) of the 100th Legislature becomes a part of the state constitution of 1963 as provided in section 1 of article XII of the state constitution of 1963.
