## **HOUSE BILL NO. 6109**

August 17, 2020, Introduced by Reps. O'Malley and Meerman and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 2016 PA 407, entitled "Skilled trades regulation act,"

by amending section 509 (MCL 339.5509) and by adding section 603a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 509. (1) After an investigation is conducted, subject to
- 2 section 603a, the department may issue an order summarily
- 3 suspending a license issued under this act based on an affidavit by
- 4 an individual who is familiar with the facts set forth in the





- 1 affidavit, or, if appropriate, based on an affidavit made on
- 2 information and belief, that an imminent threat to the public
- 3 health, safety, and welfare exists. After a summary suspension
- 4 order is issued under this section, the department shall promptly
- 5 commence the administrative proceedings described in this article
- 6 to determine what additional administrative action is appropriate.
- 7 (2) If a person's license is summarily suspended under this
- 8 section, the person may petition the department to dissolve the
- 9 order. If it receives a petition under this subsection, the
- 10 department shall immediately schedule a hearing to decide whether
- 11 to grant or deny the request to dissolve the order.
- 12 (3) An administrative law hearings examiner shall grant a
- 13 request to dissolve a summary suspension order made under
- 14 subsection (2), unless sufficient evidence is presented that an
- 15 imminent threat to the public health, safety, and welfare exists
- 16 that requires emergency action and continuation of the director's
- 17 summary suspension order.
- 18 (4) The record created at the hearing to dissolve a summary
- 19 suspension order shall become part of the record on the complaint
- 20 at a subsequent contested case hearing.
- Sec. 603a. (1) Subject to subsection (2), a licensee or
- 22 registrant who engages in conduct that violates an executive order
- 23 issued by the governor during a state of disaster or emergency
- 24 declared under the emergency management act, 1976 PA 390, MCL
- 25 30.401 to 30.421, or 1945 PA 302, MCL 10.31 to 10.33, relating to
- 26 COVID-19, shall not be subject to either of the following:
- 27 (a) An order summarily suspending a license or certificate of
- 28 registration under section 509.
- 29 (b) Any penalty described in section 603.

- 4 (3) As used in this section, "COVID-19" means severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2).

- 8 07349'20 a) of the 100th Legislature is enacted into law.
