

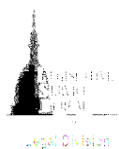
HOUSE BILL NO. 6149

September 02, 2020, Introduced by Rep. Iden and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled
"Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"
by amending section 513 (MCL 436.1513), as amended by 2020 PA 121.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 513. (1) The commission may issue to the governing board
2 of a college or university, without regard to the quota provisions
3 of section 531, a license to sell alcoholic liquor for consumption
4 on the premises of a conference center operated by the governing

board. Licenses granted under this subsection may be used only for the sale of alcoholic liquor at regularly scheduled conference center activities. The sale of alcoholic liquor to unscheduled patrons or at unscheduled events is prohibited under this subsection.

(2) Subject to section 531, the commission may issue a license to a private entity for the sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises of a hotel located on land owned by Central Michigan University if both of the following circumstances exist:

(a) The land is leased or subleased at fair market value to a private entity that owns, leases, or subleases the hotel building and its fixtures.

(b) The hotel and land are located within an industrial, research, or commercial development park established by the governing board of Central Michigan University.

(3) Subject to section 531, the commission may issue a license to a private entity for the sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the licensed premises of a restaurant located on land owned by Wayne State University if both of the following circumstances exist:

(a) The land is leased or subleased at fair market value to a private entity that owns, leases, or subleases the licensed premises for the operation of a restaurant.

(b) The restaurant is located within an area designated for industrial, research, or commercial development by the governing board of Wayne State University.

(4) Subject to section 531, the commission may issue a license to a private entity for the sale of alcoholic liquor for

2 land owned by Western Michigan University if both of the following
3 circumstances exist:

4 (a) The land is leased or subleased at fair market value to a
5 private entity that owns, leases, or subleases the licensed
6 premises for the operation of a restaurant.

7 (b) The restaurant is located within an area designated
8 industrial, research, or commercial development by the governing
9 board of Western Michigan University.

10 (5) Subject to section 531, the commission may issue to the
11 governing board of Northern Michigan University a license for the
12 sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the licensed premises
13 of a restaurant located on land owned and operated by Northern
14 Michigan University if both of the following apply:

15 (a) The license was originally acquired on the open market at
16 fair market value.

17 (b) The restaurant is located within an area designated for
18 community development or conference activities by the governing
19 board of Northern Michigan University.

20 (6) Subject to section 531, the commission may issue a license
21 to a golf course clubhouse and any adjacent outdoor service area
22 owned or operated by a college or university for the sale of
23 alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises of the golf course
24 clubhouse and any adjacent outdoor service area.

25 **(7) Subject to section 531, the commission may issue a license**
26 **to a private entity for the sale of alcoholic liquor for**
27 **consumption on the premises of a baseball stadium located on land**
28 **owned by Eastern Michigan University if the baseball stadium and**
29 **adjacent outdoor service area is leased or subleased at fair market**



1 value during the summer period between the end of the university's
2 spring term and the beginning of its fall term.

3 (8) Subject to section 531, the commission may issue a license
4 to a private entity for the sale of alcoholic liquor for
5 consumption on the premises of a baseball stadium located on land
6 owned by Oakland University if the baseball stadium and adjacent
7 outdoor service area is leased or subleased at fair market value
8 during the summer period between the end of the university's spring
9 term and the beginning of its fall term.

10 (9) ~~(7)~~ Licenses issued under this section are
11 nontransferable, and the licensee shall pay the fee required under
12 section 525.

13 (10) ~~(8)~~ As used in this section:

14 (a) "College" or "university" means a 2-year or 4-year state
15 supported institution of higher education.

16 (b) "Conference center" means a building or portion of a
17 building, other than a student residence hall or student center,
18 that has meeting rooms, banquet areas, social halls, overnight
19 accommodations, and related facilities for special activities
20 scheduled by the college or university, and that, in the judgment
21 of the commission, has been regularly used for conferences and
22 lodging of guests. All of the following are considered conference
23 centers for the purpose of this act:

24 (i) The convocation center, the corporate education center,
25 Pease Auditorium, and McKenny Hall at Eastern Michigan University.

26 (ii) The Kirkhof and Eberhard Centers at Grand Valley State
27 University.

28 (iii) The student center with the name designated by the
29 governing board of Western Michigan University and Heritage Hall

- 2 (iv) The Wadsworth Center at Michigan Technological University.
- 3 (v) The West Complex, Fredericks Sculpture Museum, and Alumni

- 17 (xiii) The Marie Pahl College Center at Mott Community College.
- 18 (xiv) The West Hall Innovation Center, the Gerald and Frances
- 19 Oleson Center, the Dennon Museum Center, and the Great Lakes Campus
- 20 at Northwestern Michigan College.
- 21 (xv) The Farmhouse at Delta College.
- 22 (xvi) The Oakland Community College Culinary Studies Institute.
