A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 16177 (MCL 333.16177), as amended by 2006 PA 481.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 16177. (1) An individual applying for licensure or
- 2 registration under this article shall do so on a form provided by
- 3 the department. The department shall require each applicant to





- 1 include on the application form his or her social security Social
- 2 Security number. The department shall not display an applicant's
- 3 social security Social Security number on his or her license or
- 4 registration. If the facts set forth in the application meet the
- 5 requirements of the board or task force and this article for
- 6 licensure or registration, the board or task force shall grant a
- 7 license or registration to the applicant. A board or task force may
- 8 require the applicant to take an examination to determine if the
- 9 applicant meets the qualifications for licensure or registration.
- 10 The In addition to English, the examination must be offered in
- 11 multiple languages as determined appropriate by the board or task
- 12 force and the examination shall must include subjects determined by
- 13 the board or task force to be essential to the safe and competent
- 14 practice of the health profession, the appropriate use of a title,
- 15 or both. Passing scores or the procedure used to determine passing
- 16 scores $\frac{\text{shall }\text{must}}{\text{be}}$ be established before an examination is
- 17 administered.
- 18 (2) In addition to the information required under subsection
- 19 (1), an applicant for licensure or registration or a licensee or
- 20 registrant applying for renewal shall include on a form provided by
- 21 the department all of the following information, if applicable:
- 22 (a) A felony conviction.
- 23 (b) A misdemeanor conviction punishable by imprisonment for a
- 24 maximum term of 2 years or a misdemeanor conviction involving the
- 25 illegal delivery, possession, or use of alcohol or a controlled
- 26 substance.
- 27 (c) Sanctions imposed against the applicant by a similar
- 28 licensure, registration, certification, or disciplinary board of
- 29 another state or country.



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- (3) In addition to the information required under subsections
 (1) and (2), a physician, osteopathic physician, dentist, or
 podiatrist applying for licensure or renewal under this article
 shall report to the department on a form provided by the department
 the name of each hospital with which he or she is employed or under
- 6 contract, and each hospital in which he or she is allowed to7 practice.
- 8 (4) In addition to the information required under subsections 9 (1), (2), and (3), an applicant for licensure and, beginning with 10 the license renewal cycle after the effective date of the 11 amendatory act that added section 16213, December 22, 2006, a 12 licensee applying for renewal shall provide the department, on the 13 application or the license renewal form, with an affidavit stating 14 that he or she has a written policy for protecting, maintaining, 15 and providing access to his or her medical records in accordance
- with section 16213 and for complying with section 16213 in the
 event that he or she sells or closes his or her practice, retires
 from practice, or otherwise ceases to practice under this article.
- 19 The applicant or licensee shall make the written policy available
 20 to the department upon on request.
 - (5) A requirement under this section to include a social security Social Security number on an application does not apply to an applicant who demonstrates that he or she is exempt under law from obtaining a social security Social Security number or to an applicant who for religious convictions is exempt under law from disclosure of his or her social security Social Security number under these circumstances. The department shall inform the applicant of this possible exemption.

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
