THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 767a. If an elector's absent voter ballot is received by
- 2 the city or township clerk after the close of the polls or if an
- 3 elector's absent voter ballot is rejected for any reason described
- 4 in section 767, the city or township clerk who retains and
- 5 preserves that ballot shall, no later than 30 days after the





- 1 election results are certified, mail a postcard notice to that
 2 elector indicating both of the following:
- 3 (a) That the elector's absent voter ballot was not counted.
- 4 (b) The reason the elector's absent voter ballot was not 5 counted.
