A bill to require the deferral of certain payroll taxes for certain employees of this state; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state governmental officers and entities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- (a) "Memorandum" means the Memorandum on Deferring Payroll Tax
 Obligations in Light of the Ongoing COVID-19 Disaster issued by the
 President of the United States on August 8, 2020.
- 5 (b) "Qualifying employee" means an employee of the executive





or legislative branch of state government who qualifies for thedeferral of payroll taxes as described in the memorandum.

3 Sec. 3. This state shall defer paying payroll taxes with 4 respect to all qualifying employees pursuant to the memorandum and any quidance, rules, or regulations issued by the Secretary of the 5 Treasury of the United States under the memorandum. This state 6 7 shall pay to a qualifying employee the amount of payroll taxes 8 deferred with respect to that employee. If this state or a 9 qualifying employee is required to pay to the federal government 10 the payroll taxes that are deferred, this state and the qualifying 11 employee shall each pay 50% of the amount owed to the federal 12 government.

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
