A bill to amend 2000 PA 305, entitled "Uniform electronic transactions act,"

by amending section 18 (MCL 450.848) and by adding section 18a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 18. (1) Except as otherwise provided in section 12(6),
- 2 the department of technology, management, and budget shall
