HOUSE BILL NO. 6333

November 12, 2020, Introduced by Rep. Steven Johnson and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1893 PA 58, entitled

"An act to provide for selecting seats for members in the hall of the house of representatives,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 4.61).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As a part of the organization of the house of
- 2 representatives upon on the first day of the first regular session
- 3 of each legislature, the seats in the hall of the house shall must
- 4 be selected by the members in a manner as follows: The clerk shall
- 5 call the names of the members having the greatest total length of

service in the house who shall select a seat. In like manner, the 1 clerk shall call the names of members in the order of their total 2 length of service in the house, who shall select seats of their 3 choice not already selected, down to and including those members 4 commencing their second terms. If there are 2 or more members who 5 6 have an equal length of service the clerk shall prepare a list of 7 their names and place opposite each name a number, which shall be 8 drawn by lottery as prescribed in this section for members entering 9 their first terms. The clerk shall then prepare a list of members 10 entering upon their first terms, listing the names of such members 11 alphabetically and placing opposite each name numbers in 12 consecutive order from 1, using as many numbers as are necessary. A 13 box shall be provided in which shall be deposited numbered white 14 balls, which shall bear the same numbers as those appearing on said 15 list. A boy or girl, selected by the clerk, then being blindfolded 16 shall draw from the box 1 ball and hand it to the clerk, who shall 17 announce the number on the ball, and the clerk shall call the 18 member's name found on the list opposite the corresponding number, 19 who shall then select a seat not previously selected. In like 20 manner all members entering upon their first terms shall select 21 seats. Any representative-elect necessarily absent on the first day of the session may, in writing, appoint any representative to 22 select a seat for him, and if no one appears for such absent 23 24 representative elect, then the clerk of the house shall make a 25 selection for him, when his name is called.prescribed by the clerk 26 of the house of representatives.
