CHAPTER 2

Sec. 5. (1) The administrator may adopt, amend, and repeal

rules relating to the administration and enforcement of this

ordinance, but not in conflict with the ordinance, subject to the

- 2 the rules, amendments, and repeals, after approval by the city
- 3 governing body, shall become effective upon being published in the

- 6 governing body, become effective upon notice being posted as set
- 7 forth in the local government public notice act.
