A bill to establish the privacy rights of the residents of this state; and to define the type of business that may collect personal data in this state.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "Michigan consumer privacy act".
- 3 Sec. 3. The residents of this state have all of the following
- 4 rights:
- 5 (a) To know what personal data is being collected about them.

- (b) To know whether their personal data is sold or disclosed
  and to whom.
- 3 (c) To say no to the sale of personal data.
- 4 (d) To access the personal data that has been collected about

- **6** (e) To request that a business delete any personal information
- 7 about a consumer collected from that consumer.
- **8** (f) To not be discriminated against for exercising the privacy
- 9 rights described in this act.
- Sec. 5. A person that operates as a for-profit business shall
- 11 not collect personal data from the residents of this state unless
- 12 it meets 1 or more of the following:
- 13 (a) The person annually buys, receives, sells, or shares the
- 14 personal information of 50,000 or more consumers, households, or
- 15 devices.
- 16 (b) The person has annual gross revenue of more than
- **17** \$25,000,000.00.
- 18 (c) The person derives 50% or more of its annual revenue from
- 19 selling consumer personal information.
