## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 67a. (1) A prisoner who receives nonemergency medical,
- 2 dental  $\tau$  or optometric services at his or her request is
- 3 responsible for a copayment fee to the department for those
- 4 services, as determined by the department. If the prisoner is a
- 5 minor, the prisoner's parent or guardian is also responsible for a

- 1 copayment fee imposed under this section.subsection.
- 2 (2) A prisoner who intentionally injures himself or herself,
- 3 and receives emergency medical care for that injury, is responsible
- 4 for the entire cost of the medical care. , rather than the
- 5 copayment described in subsection (1).
- **6** (3) The department shall determine whether those prisoners who
- 7 injure themselves intentionally shall described under subsection
- 8 (2) will be housed in a facility designed to allow on-site medical
- 9 treatment of those intentional injuries. Not later than 6 months
- 10 after the effective date of this section, September 30, 1997, the
- 11 director of the department shall report to the legislature on the
- 12 feasibility and cost of implementing this subsection.
