THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1. (1) For a sale of goods, services, or memberships whose value equals or exceeds with a value that equals or exceeds \$500.00, if the buyer has been offered anything of more than \$25.00 in value in exchange for attending a sales promotion for those goods, services, or memberships, in addition to any other right to

revoke an offer, a buyer has the right to cancel the sale and 1 2 receive a complete refund until midnight of the third tenth business day after the day on which the buyer signed a contract or 3 4 agreement to purchase. (2) A contract or agreement to purchase which that is subject 5 to cancellation under the provisions of subsection (1) shall must 6 prominently contain the following notice, on its face, set in 7 boldface at least 4 points larger than the type of the body of the 8 document, the notice to purchaser described in this subsection. cancellation notice is given on the date the notice is postmarked.

- (4) A written notice given by the buyer for cancellation need not take a particular form and is sufficient if it indicates by any form of written expression the intention of the buyer not to be bound by the sale.
- (5) A buyer shall not cancel a sale if the buyer requests the seller to provide goods, services, or memberships without delay because of an emergency, and any of the following apply:
- (a) The seller in good faith makes a substantial beginning of performance of the contract before the buyer gives notice of cancellation.
- (b) The buyer furnishes the seller with a separate dated and signed personal statement in the buyer's handwriting describing the situation requiring immediate remedy and expressly acknowledging and waiving the right to cancel the sale within 3-10 business days.
- (c) The goods, services, or memberships cannot be returned to the seller in substantially as good condition as when received by the buyer.
- (6) This act does not limit or in any way affect a buyer's right to cancel a sale under any other provision of law.
- (7) If a gift is given to the prospective buyer as an inducement to attend a sales promotion, regardless of intent, the prospective buyer shall have the right to keep the gift without obligation whether or not a contract is canceled.
