A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending section 311 (MCL 168.311), as amended by 2014 PA 94.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 311. (1) If less than a majority of the offices of school
- 2 board member of a school district become vacant, the remaining
- 3 school board members shall, subject to subsection (2), fill each
