THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1176. Subject to state and federal privacy laws, if a
- 2 school district, intermediate school district, or public school
- 3 academy receives notification that a pupil enrolled in, an employee
- 4 of, or an individual assigned to work at the school district,

- 12 (ii) Must not be in an amount that is greater than 45 minutes
- 13 before each break for pupils enrolled in grades 4 to 6.
- 14 (iii) Must not be in an amount that is greater than 60 minutes
- 15 before each break for pupils enrolled in grades 7 to 12.
