

SENATE BILL NO. 20

January 15, 2019, Introduced by Senator ZORN and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
by amending section 317a (MCL 750.317a), as added by 2005 PA 167.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 317a. **(1)** A person who delivers a schedule 1 or 2
2 controlled substance, other than marihuana, to another person in
3 violation of section 7401 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368,
4 MCL 333.7401, that is consumed by that person or any other person
5 and that causes the death of that person or other person is guilty

1 of a felony punishable by imprisonment for life or any term of
2 years.

3 (2) A violation of this section may be prosecuted in the
4 county in which any of the following occurred:

5 (a) The county in which delivery of the controlled substance
6 was made.

7 (b) The county in which the controlled substance was consumed.

8 (c) The county in which the death caused by the delivery of
9 the controlled substance occurred.

10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
11 after the date it is enacted into law.

12 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
13 unless Senate Bill No. 21

14 of the 100th Legislature is enacted into law.
