SENATE BILL NO. 25

January 15, 2019, Introduced by Senator MCBROOM and referred to the Committee on Education and Career Readiness.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending section 282a (MCL 168.282a) and by adding section 282b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 282a. At its fall state convention of 1964, each
- 2 political party may nominate 8 candidates for membership on the
- 3 state board of education. Two candidates shall be nominated for 2-
- 4 year terms, 2 for 4-year terms, 2 for 6-year terms and 2 for 8-year
- 5 terms. At its fall state convention of 1966, and every 2 years

- 1 thereafter, each political party may, subject to section 282b,
- 2 nominate 2 candidates for membership on the state board of
- 3 education.
- 4 Sec. 282b. (1) In order to better promote a diversity of
- 5 perspectives on the state board of education representative of the
- 6 great diversity of schools, students, and communities across the
- 7 many regions of this state, it is the intent of the legislature
- 8 that members of the state board of education be nominated by
- 9 regions, but still be elected and serve statewide.
- 10 (2) Beginning on the effective date of the amendatory act that
- 11 added this section, this state is divided into 8 regions for each
- 12 political party to select members to the state board of education.
- 13 The regions are constituted as follows:
- 14 (a) Region 1 which consists of the counties of Alger, Baraga,
- 15 Chippewa, Delta, Dickinson, Gogebic, Houghton, Iron, Keweenaw,
- 16 Luce, Mackinac, Marquette, Menominee, Ontonagon, and Schoolcraft.
- 17 (b) Region 2 which consists of the counties of Alcona, Alpena,
- 18 Antrim, Arenac, Benzie, Charlevoix, Cheboygan, Clare, Crawford,
- 19 Emmet, Gladwin, Grand Traverse, Iosco, Kalkaska, Lake, Leelanau,
- 20 Manistee, Mason, Missaukee, Montmorency, Ogemaw, Osceola, Oscoda,
- 21 Otsego, Presque Isle, Roscommon, and Wexford.
- 22 (c) Region 3 which consists of the counties of Gratiot, Ionia,
- 23 Isabella, Kent, Mecosta, Midland, Montcalm, Muskegon, Newaygo,
- 24 Oceana, and Ottawa.
- 25 (d) Region 4 which consists of the counties of Bay, Genesee,
- 26 Huron, Lapeer, Saginaw, St. Clair, Sanilac, Shiawassee, and
- 27 Tuscola.
- (e) Region 5 which consists of the counties of Allegan, Barry,
- 29 Berrien, Branch, Cass, Calhoun, Kalamazoo, St. Joseph, and Van

- 1 Buren.
- 2 (f) Region 6 which consists of the counties of Clinton, Eaton,
- 3 Hillsdale, Ingham, Jackson, Lenawee, Livingston, Monroe, and
- 4 Washtenaw.
- 5 (g) Region 7 which consists of the counties of Macomb and 6 Oakland.
- 7 (h) Region 8 which consists of Wayne County.
- 8 (3) Beginning on the effective date of the amendatory act that 9 added this section, each political party may nominate candidates
- 10 for membership on the state board of education as follows:
- 11 (a) At its fall state convention of 2020, and every 8 years
- 12 thereafter, each political party may nominate for membership on the
- 13 state board of education 1 candidate who is a resident of region 1
- 14 and 1 candidate who is a resident of region 5, or any individual
- 15 elected to and serving a term of office on the state board of
- 16 education on the effective date of the amendatory act that added
- 17 this section.
- 18 (b) At its fall state convention of 2022, and every 8 years
- 19 thereafter, each political party may nominate for membership on the
- 20 state board of education 1 candidate who is a resident of region 3
- 21 and 1 candidate who is a resident of region 7, or any individual
- 22 elected to and serving a term of office on the state board of
- 23 education on the effective date of the amendatory act that added
- 24 this section.
- 25 (c) At its fall state convention of 2024, and every 8 years
- 26 thereafter, each political party may nominate for membership on the
- 27 state board of education 1 candidate who is a resident of region 2
- 28 and 1 candidate who is a resident of region 6, or any individual
- 29 elected to and serving a term of office on the state board of

- education on the effective date of the amendatory act that added this section.
- 3 (d) At its fall state convention of 2026, and every 8 years
 4 thereafter, each political party may nominate for membership on the
 5 state board of education 1 candidate who is a resident of region 4
 6 and 1 candidate who is a resident of region 8, or any individual
 7 elected to and serving a term of office on the state board of
- 8 education on the effective date of the amendatory act that added
 9 this section.
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 daysafter the date it is enacted into law.
