SENATE BILL NO. 118

February 21, 2019, Introduced by Senators DALEY, WOJNO, HOLLIER, MACDONALD, HORN, LASATA, OUTMAN, VICTORY, RUNESTAD and JOHNSON and referred to the Committee on Families, Seniors and Veterans.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 803e (MCL 257.803e), as amended by 2011 PA 46.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 803e. (1) A person who has been a prisoner of war or a
- ${f 2}$ person whose spouse has been a prisoner of war may ${f make-application}$
- 3 apply to the secretary of state for a special registration plate
- 4 that shall be inscribed with special identification numbers
- ${f 5}$ preceded by the letters "EX-POW" and ${f shall \ have}$ the words "ex-
- 6 prisoner of war" inscribed beneath the registration number.

1 (2) A person who was a member of the armed services during
2 World War I may make application apply to the secretary of state
3 for a special registration plate , that shall be inscribed with
4 special identification numbers preceded by the letters "WWI" and
5 shall have the words "World War I veteran" inscribed beneath the
6 registration number.

- (3) A person who was a member of the armed services during 1941, stationed at a United States military or naval establishment at Pearl Harbor in the Hawaiian islands, and who survived the attack by Japan on Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941 may make application apply to the secretary of state for a special registration plate , that shall be inscribed with special identification numbers and shall have the words "Pearl Harbor survivor" inscribed beneath the registration number.
- Purple Heart Medal may make application apply to the secretary of state for a special registration plate that shall be inscribed with special identification numbers and shall have the words "combat wounded veteran" inscribed beneath the registration number. In addition, the special registration plate described under in this subsection shall must be inscribed with a vignette of the official purple heart medal. Purple Heart Medal.
- (5) Application for a special registration plate shall must be on a form prescribed by the secretary of state , and shall must be accompanied by any proof of the applicant having been a prisoner of war, World War I veteran, Pearl Harbor survivor, or recipient of the purple heart medal Purple Heart Medal that the secretary of state may require. Application for a "Gold Star Family" special registration plate described in subsection (9) shall or a "Blue"

- 1 Star Family" special registration plate described in subsection
- 2 (10) must be on a form prescribed by the secretary of state and
- 3 shall must be accompanied by any proof of the applicant having been
- 4 a gold star or blue star family member that the secretary of state
- 5 may require. The application for a special registration plate shall
- 6 must also be accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee.
- 7 (6) Upon proper application and payment of the \$5.00 service
- 8 fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special
- 9 registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger
- 10 vehicle. A person who is disabled who makes application for a
- 11 special registration plate under this section and who makes payment
- 12 of the \$5.00 service fee shall must be issued a tab for persons
- 13 with disabilities as provided in section 803f for his or her
- 14 special registration plate. The secretary of state shall require
- 15 the same proof that the applicant is a disabled person as is
- 16 required for issuance of a permanent windshield placard under
- 17 section 675. One person in any household is entitled to 1 special
- 18 registration plate issued under subsection (1) that is exempt from
- 19 payment of the tax provided in section 801. The person who is
- 20 issued an additional special registration plate under subsection
- 21 (1) shall be assessed the applicable tax provided for in section
- 22 801. A person issued 1 or more special registration plates under
- 23 subsection (2), (3), (4), or (9), shall or (10) must be assessed
- 24 the applicable tax provided in section 801.
- 25 (7) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other
- 26 than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who
- 27 does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.
- 28 (8) The special registration plate issued under this section
- 29 expires on the birthday of the vehicle owner in a year in which new

- 1 plates are issued by the secretary of state. Application for
- 2 renewal of the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a
- 3 \$5.00 service fee. The applicant is not required to furnish the
- 4 proof provided in subsection (5).
- 5 (9) A gold star family member may make application apply to
- 6 the secretary of state for a special registration plate that shall
- 7 be inscribed with special identification numbers preceded by a gold
- 8 star and shall have the words "Gold Star Family" inscribed beneath
- 9 the registration number.
- 10 (10) A member of a blue star family may apply to the secretary
- 11 of state for a special registration plate inscribed with special
- 12 identification numbers preceded by a Blue Star Families insignia
- 13 and the words "Blue Star Family" beneath the registration number.
- 14 (11) (10) As used in this section: , "gold star family member"
- 15 (a) "Blue star family member" means a person who is currently
- 16 serving in the United States Armed Forces or in forces incorporated
- 17 as part of the United States Armed Forces or a person who has an
- 18 immediate family member serving in the United States Armed Forces
- 19 or in forces incorporated as part of the United States Armed
- 20 Forces. As used in this subdivision, "immediate family member"
- 21 means a parent, stepparent, adoptive parent, foster parent standing
- 22 in loco parentis, child, stepchild, adopted child, sibling, half-
- 23 sibling, spouse, or grandparent.
- 24 (b) "Gold star family member" means a person who has had an
- 25 immediate family member die while serving in the United States
- 26 armed forces Armed Forces or in forces incorporated as part of the
- 27 United States armed forces Armed Forces if the immediate family
- 28 member meets any of the eligibility criteria specified in 10 USC
- 29 1126(a)(1) to (3) for a gold star lapel button.
