SENATE BILL NO. 125

February 26, 2019, Introduced by Senator BARRETT and referred to the Committee on Families, Seniors and Veterans.

A bill to amend 1995 PA 29, entitled "Uniform unclaimed property act,"

by amending section 18 (MCL 567.238), as amended by 2010 PA 197.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 18. (1) A person holding property presumed abandoned and
- 2 subject to the this state's custody as unclaimed property under
- 3 this act shall report to the administrator concerning the property
- 4 as provided in this section.
- 5 (2) The report shall must be verified and shall must include
- 6 all of the following:

or money orders.

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- 7 (b) In the case of For unclaimed funds of \$50.00 or more held 8 or owing under any life or endowment insurance policy or annuity 9 contract, the full name and last known address of the insured or 10 annuitant and of the beneficiary according to the records of the 11 insurance company holding or owing the funds.
- 12 (c) In the case of For the contents of a safe deposit box or
 13 other safekeeping repository or of other tangible property, a
 14 description of the property and the place where it is held and may
 15 be inspected by the administrator and any amounts owing to the
 16 holder.
- (d) The nature and identifying number, if any, or description of the property and the amount appearing from the records to be due. However, items of value under \$50.00 each may be reported in the aggregate.
- (e) The date the property became payable, demandable, or
 returnable, and the date of the last transaction with the apparent
 owner with respect to the property.
- (f) Other information the administrator requires by rule asnecessary for the administration of this act.
- 26 (3) If the person holding property presumed abandoned and
 27 subject to the this state's custody as unclaimed property under
 28 this act is a successor to other persons who previously held the
 29 property for the apparent owner, or the holder has changed its name

- while holding the property, the holder shall file with the report
 all known names and addresses of each previous holder of the
 property.
- 4 (4) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the 5 report shall must be filed on or before November 1 of each year for 6 the 12-month period ending on the immediately preceding June 30. 7 However, in 2011, the report shall be filed on or before July 1, 8 2011 for the 9-month period ending on March 31, 2011, and for years 9 ending after December 31, 2011, the report shall be filed on or 10 before July 1-2 of each year for the 12-month period ending on the 11 immediately preceding March 31. The administrator may postpone the 12 date to file a report —on written request by any person required 13 to file a report under this section. The administrator may extend 14 the filing date for up to 60 days after the deadline if an 15 estimated payment is paid on or before the deadline for the 16 applicable period. Remittance of an estimated payment without a 17 report on or before the deadline shall must be considered a request 18 for extension. A request for extension of time to file the report 19 is not a request for an extension of time to remit payments. 20 Interest and penalties will not accrue during the extension period
 - (5) Not less than 60 days or more than 365 days before filing the report required by this section, the holder in possession of property presumed abandoned and subject to the state's custody as unclaimed property under this act shall send written notice to the apparent owner at his or her last known address informing him or her that the holder is in possession of property subject to this act if all of the following requirements are met:

against a person who remits an estimated payment. The administrator

shall determine how estimated payments are to be remitted.

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- (a) The holder has in its records an address for the apparent
 owner that the holder's records do not disclose to be inaccurate.
- 3 (b) The claim of the apparent owner is not barred by the4 statute of limitations.
- 5 (c) The property has a value of \$50.00 or more or, if the 6 holder filing a report under this section is reporting for the 7 current report year at least 25,000 properties over \$50.00 each, 8 the property has a value of \$100.00 or more.
- 9 (6) There is appropriated from funds money generated by 10 unclaimed properties deposited under this act the sum of 11 \$4,800,000.00 to the department of treasury for administration and 12 public awareness of unclaimed property filing and compliance 13 requirements created by the amendatory act that added this 14 subsection. This appropriation is allotted for expenditure on and 15 after October 1, September 30, 2010. The appropriation authorized 16 in this subsection is a work project appropriation, and any 17 unencumbered or unallotted funds are carried forward into the 18 following year. The following is in compliance with section 451a(1) 19 of the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:
 - (a) The purpose of the project is to provide technical and administrative support for the 2011 unclaimed property program in the department of treasury. Costs related to this project will include, but are not limited to:
- 24 (i) Information technology system changes.
- 25 (ii) Staffing-related costs.

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- 26 (iii) Costs to promote public awareness.
- 27 (iv) Any other costs related to implementation of the program.
- (b) The work project will be accomplished through the use ofinteragency agreements, grants, state employees, and contracts.

- 1 Contracts, if any, for the work project authorized by this
- 2 subsection shall must be subject to competitive solicitation of
- 3 bids from the private sector in compliance with section 261 of the
- 4 management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1261.
- 5 (c) The total estimated completion cost of the project is6 \$4,800,000.00.
- 7 (d) The expected completion date is September 30, 2012.
- 8 (7) The provisions modifying of 2010 PA 197 that modified the
- 9 dormancy periods of the amendatory act that added this subsection
- 10 do not apply if the owner of the property is on active duty
- 11 military service. outside the United States.
