A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 17744b (MCL 333.17744b), as amended by 2016 PA 384.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 17744b. (1) Notwithstanding any provision of this act to
- 2 the contrary, a prescriber may issue a prescription for and a
- 3 dispensing prescriber or pharmacist may dispense an opioid
- 4 antagonist to any of the following:

- (a) An individual patient at risk of experiencing an opioid related overdose.

- 8 (d) A person other than an individual that meets all of the 9 following requirements:
- 10 (i) Acts at the direction of the prescriber or dispensing 11 prescriber.
- 12 (ii) Upon receipt of an opioid antagonist, stores the opioid13 antagonist in compliance with this part.
- 14 (iii) Dispenses or administers an opioid antagonist under a15 valid prescription issued to an individual or a patient.
- 16 (iv) Performs the requirements under this subsection without17 charge or compensation.
- 18 (e) A public library for purposes of the administration of 19 opioid antagonists by library employees act.

- (2) When issuing a prescription for or dispensing an opioid antagonist as authorized under this section to a school board, a public library, or a person other than a patient, the prescriber, dispensing prescriber, or pharmacist, as appropriate, shall insert the name of the school board, the public library, or the person as the name of the patient.
- (3) Notwithstanding any provision of this act to the contrary,
 a person that is acting in good faith and with reasonable care may
 possess and dispense an opioid antagonist.
