## **SENATE BILL NO. 227**

March 19, 2019, Introduced by Senators MACGREGOR and SCHMIDT and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 188, entitled

"An act to provide for the making of certain improvements by townships; to provide for paying for the improvements by the issuance of bonds; to provide for the levying of taxes; to provide for assessing the whole or a part of the cost of improvements against property benefited; and to provide for the issuance of bonds in anticipation of the collection of special assessments and for the obligation of the township on the bonds,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 41.722), as amended by 2002 PA 585.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 2. (1) The following improvements may be made under this

- (a) The construction, improvement, and maintenance of storm or
   sanitary sewers or the improvement and maintenance of, but not the
   construction of new or expanded, combined storm and sanitary sewer

- 5 (b) The construction, improvement, and maintenance of water6 systems.

  8 roads.

- 2 (o) The construction, improvement, and maintenance of dams and
- ${f 3}$  other structures that retain the waters of this state for
- 4 recreational purposes.
- 5 (p) The construction, improvement, and maintenance of sound
- 6 attenuation walls, pavement, or other sound mitigation treatments
- 7 unless a written objection is filed in the same manner as provided
- 8 under section 3 by the record owners of land constituting more than
- 9 20% of the total area in the proposed special assessment district.
- 10 If a written objection is filed, then the township board shall not
- 11 proceed with the improvement until a petition signed by the record
- 12 owners of land constituting more than 50% of the total land area in
- 13 the special assessment district as finally established is filed
- 14 with the board.
- 15 (2) A road under the jurisdiction of either the state

- 3 (3) A lake, pond, river, stream, lagoon, or other body of 4 water under the jurisdiction of a county drain commissioner shall 5 must not be improved under this act without the written approval of 6 the county drain commissioner of the county in which the lake, 7 pond, river, stream, lagoon, or other body of water is located.
