

SENATE BILL NO. 238

March 21, 2019, Introduced by Senators ALEXANDER, BULLOCK, WOJNO, HOLLIER, HERTEL, CHANG, GEISS, IRWIN, ANANICH, BRINKS and MCCANN and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to recognize the month of April of each year as Sarcoidosis Awareness Month.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. Recognizing the need for a greater understanding of
2 the causes and nature of the chronic, multisystem disease known as
3 sarcoidosis, a deepened appreciation for the courage and
4 determination demonstrated by the victims of sarcoidosis and their
5 family members, a greater acknowledgment of the important efforts
6 of other concerned Americans engaged in promoting better treatment
7 and support for those afflicted by the disease, and a wider

1 recognition of the research efforts of concerned physicians,
2 scientists, and researchers in this state and throughout the nation
3 as they work toward a cure, the month of April of each year shall
4 be known as "Sarcoidosis Awareness Month" in this state.

5 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
6 date it is enacted into law.
