April 30, 2019, Introduced by Senators BIZON, LUCIDO, HERTEL, ANANICH, BRINKS, BULLOCK, GEISS, RUNESTAD, ALEXANDER, BAYER, WOJNO, MCMORROW, POLEHANKI and HOLLIER and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety.
