A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 8030 (MCL 257.8030), as amended by 1999 PA 183.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 803o. (1) On and after December 18, 1992, a person who
- 2 was a member or a person whose spouse was a member of the Michigan
- 3 national guard, National Guard, the United States armed forces
- 4 reserve, Armed Forces Reserve, or any branch of the armed services

- 1 of the United States and who was called to active duty during a
- 2 declared war or an armed conflict in which the United States was a
- 3 participant may apply to the secretary of state for a special
- 4 registration plate , which shall display that displays an
- 5 appropriate vignette preceding the registration numbers and shall
- 6 have has the word "veteran" inscribed beneath the registration
- 7 numbers.
- 8 (2) Application for a special registration plate shall must be
- 9 on a form prescribed by the secretary of state, and shall must be
- 10 accompanied by any proof of the applicant or applicant's spouse
- 11 having been a veteran of a declared war or an armed conflict in
- 12 which the United States was a participant that the secretary of
- 13 state may require. The application for a special registration plate
- 14 shall also be accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee.
- 15 (3) Upon proper application, and payment of the \$5.00 service
- 16 fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special
- 17 registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger
- 18 vehicle. A person who is disabled who applies for a special
- 19 registration plate under this section and who pays the \$5.00
- 20 service fee shall must be issued a tab for persons with
- 21 disabilities as provided in section 803f for his or her special
- 22 registration plate. The secretary of state shall require the same
- 23 proof that the applicant is a disabled person as is required for
- 24 issuance of a permanent windshield placard under section 675. A
- 25 person issued 1 or more special registration plates under
- 26 subsection (1) shall must be assessed the applicable tax provided
- 27 in section 801.
- 28 (4) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other
- 29 than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who

- 1 does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.
- 2 (5) The special registration plate issued under this section
- 3 shall expire expires on the birthday of the vehicle owner. When new
- 4 plates are issued by the secretary of state, application for
- 5 renewal of the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a
- 6 \$5.00 service fee. The applicant shall is not be required to
- 7 furnish the proof provided in subsection (2) for an application for
- 8 renewal of the special registration plate.
