## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 806. (1) Until October 1, 2019, an applicant for a
- 2 certificate of title required by this act or an applicant for a
- 3 duplicate of a certificate of title shall accompany the application
- 4 with a fee of \$10.00. An applicant who requests that the
- 5 application be given special expeditious treatment shall accompany

- 1 the application with an additional fee of \$5.00. The secretary of
- 2 state shall collect a \$3.00 service fee, in addition to the other
- 3 fees collected under this subsection, for each title issued and
- 4 shall deposit the fee in the transportation administration
- 5 collection fund created under section 810b through October 1, 2019.
- 6 The \$5.00 expeditious treatment fee collected on and after October
- 7 1, 2004 through October 1, 2019 shall must be deposited into the
- 8 transportation administration collection fund created under section
- 9 810b.
- 10 (2) An applicant for a special identifying number under11 section 230 shall accompany the application with a fee of \$10.00.
- 12 (3) In addition to paying the fees required by subsection (1),
- 13 until December 31, 2019, October 1, 2023, each person who applies
- 14 for a certificate of title, a salvage vehicle certificate of title,
- 15 or a scrap certificate of title under this act shall pay a tire
- 16 disposal surcharge of \$1.50 for each certificate of title or
- 17 duplicate of a certificate of title that person receives. The
- 18 secretary of state shall deposit money received under this
- 19 subsection into the scrap tire regulatory fund created in section
