THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 529. (1) A person who engages in conduct proscribed under 2 section 530 and who in the course of engaging in that conduct τ
- $3\ \ \text{possesses}$ does any of the following is guilty of armed robbery:
- 4 (a) Possesses a dangerous weapon. or an
- 5 (b) Possesses an article used or fashioned in a manner to lead
 6 any that would cause a reasonable person present to reasonably

- 1 believe the article is a dangerous weapon. , or who represents
- (c) Represents orally or otherwise that he or she is in possession of possesses a dangerous weapon. 7
- 4 (2) A person who violates this section is guilty of a felony 5 punishable by imprisonment for life or for any term of years.
- 6 (3) If a violation of this section results in an aggravated
 7 assault of or serious injury is inflicted by to any other person,
 8 while violating this section, the person shall must be sentenced to
 9 a minimum term of imprisonment of not less than 2 years.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days 11 after the date it is enacted into law.
