PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

**GENERAL SECTIONS**

8           Sec. 201. In accordance with section 30 of article IX of the  
9 state constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources  
10 in this appropriation act for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
11 2020 is \$15,000,000.00 and state spending from state sources to be  
12 paid to local units of government is \$0.00.

13           Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized  
14 under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,  
15 and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are  
16 subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101  
17 to 18.1594.

**DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, GREAT LAKES, AND ENERGY**

19           Sec. 301. (1) From the funds appropriated in part 1 for PFAS  
20 and emerging contaminants, \$15,000,000.00 is allocated for a grant  
21 program for municipal airports for costs of monitoring and  
22 additional testing related to PFAS testing results.

23           (2) On or before April 1, the department shall transmit to the  
24 appropriations subcommittees, the fiscal agencies, and the state  
25 budget office and post on the department's website a report on the  
26 previous calendar year's activities funded with PFAS and emerging  
27 contaminants funds. The report shall include a list of all grantees  
28 and award amounts.
