## **SENATE BILL NO. 584**

October 15, 2019, Introduced by Senators WOJNO, GEISS, ALEXANDER, BULLOCK, CHANG, MCBROOM, HERTEL, HOLLIER and SCHMIDT and referred to the Committee on Education and Career Readiness.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1178b; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1178b. (1) The board of a school district or intermediate
- 2 school district or board of directors of a public school academy
- 3 shall ensure that a first aid response kit is installed and
- 4 maintained in each school building operated by the school district,
- 5 intermediate school district, or public school academy. The first

- 1 aid response kit must include at least all of the following:
- 2 (a) A tourniquet.
- 3 (b) Bleeding control dressings.
- 4 (c) Compression bandages.
- 5 (d) Instructions on the use of the first aid response kit
- 6 developed by the Stop the Bleed program or the American College of
- 7 Surgeons Committee on Trauma or other instructions determined
- 8 appropriate by the department.
- 9 (e) Protective gloves.
- 10 (f) A marker.
- 11 (2) The board of a school district or intermediate school
- 12 district or board of directors of a public school academy shall
- 13 ensure that all staff members of the school district, intermediate
- 14 school district, or public school academy are trained on the use
- 15 and maintenance of the first aid response kit installed under
- 16 subsection (1).
- 17 (3) A school administrator, teacher, or other school employee
- 18 designated by the school administrator, who in good faith uses a
- 19 first aid response kit in an emergency that threatens the life or
- 20 health of a pupil is not liable in a criminal action or for civil
- 21 damages as a result of an act or omission in the use of the first
- 22 aid response kit, except for an act or omission amounting to gross
- 23 negligence or willful and wanton misconduct.

- 26 (a) A building intended to be used to provide instruction for
