## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 9 (b) "Meeting" means the convening of a public body at which a

- 17 (c) "Closed session" means a meeting or part of a meeting of a
- 18 public body that is closed to the public.

- 21 order, ordinance, bill, or measure on which a vote by members of a
- 22 public body is required and by which a public body effectuates or
