## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 104a. (1) The council shall appoint a council
- 2 administrator who shall be the chief executive officer of all
- 3 legislative council agencies. The council administrator is an at-
- 4 will employee and shall serve at the pleasure of the council. The

- 1 council administrator has all the following duties and
- 2 responsibilities:
- 3 (a) To provide general supervisory oversight over all
- 4 legislative council agencies.
- 5 (b) To provide personnel policy oversight and development for
- 6 all legislative council agencies.
- 7 (c) To develop, prepare, and present legislative council
- 8 agency budgets.
- 9 (d) To review quarterly financial statements of legislative
- 10 council agencies and monitor budgetary compliance.
- 11 (e) To act as secretary to the council, including but not
- 12 limited to the following:
- 13 (i) Scheduling of meetings for the council and subcommittees.
- 14 (ii) Keeping and recording of minutes and records of meetings.
- 15 (f) To perform other duties and responsibilities as determined
- 16 and assigned by the council.
- 17 (g) To designate an individual as a LORA coordinator and to
- 18 receive and decide appeals of public record requests, as provided
- 19 in the legislative open records act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.251 to

- 21 (2) In addition to the responsibilities provided in subsection
- 22 (1), at the direction of the Michigan state capitol commission, the
- 23 council administrator shall do both of the following:
- 24 (a) Administer compensation, benefits, and other personnel
- 25 support for the employees of the Michigan state capitol commission.
- 26 (b) Administer computer, telephone, and technical support for
