THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5. (1) An-Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2),
- 2 the issuing officer shall issue a work permit only upon on an in-
- 3 person application in person by the minor desiring employment and
- 4 after having the following papers have been examined, approved, and
- 5 filed: the following papers:
- 6 (a) A statement of intention to employ the minor, signed by

- 2 prospective employer, setting forth the general nature of the
- 3 occupation in which the employer intends to employ the minor, the
- 4 hours during which the minor will be employed, the wages to be

- 7 requires.
- 8 (b) Evidence showing that the minor is of the age required by
- 9 this act. Proof of age shall must be established by one of the
- 10 following:
- (i) A certified copy of the birth record or any other proof of
- 12 age showing the place and date of birth.
- 13 (ii) A certified copy of valid operator's license issued by
- 14 this state clearly showing date of birth.
- 15 (iii) The school record or the school census record.
- 16 (iv) The sworn statement of the minor's parent or guardian,
- 17 together with a corroborating statement of a physician.
- 18 (v) If documentary proof as described in subparagraphs (i) to
- 19 (iv) is not obtainable, the issuing officer may accept other
- 20 documentation as established by department of education rules.
- 21 (2) During a state of disaster or a state of emergency issued
- 22 by the governor under the emergency management act, 1976 PA 390,
- 23 MCL 30.401 to 30.421, the requirement that a work permit
- 24 application must be made only by an in-person application by the
- 25 minor desiring employment is suspended. The issuing officer may
- 26 allow the minor desiring employment to submit the application

- 3 Sec. 6. (1) Work permits shall Except as otherwise provided in
- 4 subsections (4) and (5), a work permit must be issued in the form
- 5 prescribed by the department of education in cooperation with the
- 6 department of labor and economic opportunity and in accordance with
- 7 instructions so prescribed. The color of work permits for minors a
- 8 work permit for a minor under 16 years of age shall must be
- 9 distinct from that for minors a minor 16 years of age and over.
- 10 Work permits shall A work permit must state the name and address of
- 11 the minor, the date of birth, the occupation and industry in which
- 12 the minor is employed, the employer's name and address, and other

- 21 (3) A fee shall not be charged for a work permit or other

- 23 (4) If the governor declares a state of disaster or a state of

- 25 30.401 to 30.421, and the issuing officer issues a work permit
- 26 electronically to a minor desiring employment, the requirement that
- 27 a work permit form must be in a color described under subsection
- 28 (1) is suspended.
- 29 (5) A work permit issued during the period described in

- 1 subsection (4) and printed in a form in a color other than the
- 2 color described in subsection (1) is valid for 90 days after the
- 3 termination of the state of disaster or state of emergency. The
- 4 issuing officer shall issue the minor a work permit in the color

- 6 period.

- 8 (a) "State of disaster" means that term as defined in section
