THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
 "police restraint tactics act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act, "law enforcement officer" means

- 5 enforcement standards act, 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.602.
- **6** Sec. 3. A law enforcement officer shall not apply pressure to
- 7 the throat or windpipe of an individual.
