June 23, 2020, Introduced by Senators HERTEL, POLEHANKI, WOJNO, GEISS, HORN, MACGREGOR, CHANG, ALEXANDER, BULLOCK, ANANICH, BRINKS, BIZON, ZORN, HOLLIER and BAYER and referred to the Committee on Health Policy and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

by amending section 1177 (MCL 380.1177), as amended by 2013 PA 121.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1177. (1) A child enrolling in a public or nonpublic
- 2 school for the first time or , beginning in the 2014-2015 school
- 3 year, enrolling in grade 7 or grade 12 for the first time shall
- 4 submit 1 of the following:
- 5 (a) A statement signed by a physician that the child has been
- 6 tested for and immunized or protected against diseases specified by

- the director of the department of community health and human
 services.
- 3 (b) A statement signed by a parent or guardian to the effect
 4 that the child has not been immunized because of religious
 5 convictions or other objection to immunization.
- 6 (c) A statement signed by a physician that certifies that the7 child is in the process of complying with all immunization8 requirements.
- 9 (2) In addition, the parent or guardian of each child 10 enrolling in kindergarten for the first time shall submit a 11 statement signed by a district, county, or city health department 12 director stating that the child has been administered the department of community health and human services preschool vision 13 14 screening test, or signed by a licensed medical or osteopathic 15 physician or a licensed optometrist stating that the child's eyes 16 have been examined during the preschool years after age 3 and before initial entrance. A vision test is not required if there is 17 18 a statement signed by a parent or quardian to the effect that the 19 child cannot be submitted to the test because of religious convictions. 20
- (3) Not later than November 1 of each year, the administrator 21 22 of each school shall provide the director of the department of 23 community health and human services with the immunization status of 24 each pupil in grades K through to 12 who enrolled in the school for 25 the first time 7 or 7 beginning in the 2014-2015 school year, who enrolled in grade 7 or grade 12 in the school for the first time, 26 27 between the immediately preceding January 1 and the immediately preceding September 30, as well as a vision report of each child 28 29 entering kindergarten during that time period. - 1 shall must be transmitted through the approved local full-time
- 2 health department, if available, and shall must be on forms
- 3 provided by the director of community the department of health and
- 4 human services or otherwise reported in a manner approved by the

- 6 Not later than February 1 of each year, the administrator of each
- 7 school shall provide an update to the report due the previous
- 8 November 1 to show the immunization status of each pupil in grades
- 9 K through to 12 who enrolled in the school for the first time —or
- 10 , beginning in the 2014-2015 school year, who enrolled in grade 7
- 11 or grade 12 in the school for the first time, during the calendar
- 12 year ending the immediately preceding December 31. This information
- 13 shall must be transmitted in the same manner as the report due the
- 14 previous November 1.
- 15 (4) The—Subject to section 9227(3) of the public health code,
- 16 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.9227, the department of community health and
- 17 human services shall promulgate rules, including rules identifying
- 18 the diseases specified under subsection (1)(a), for the
- 19 implementation of this section.
- 20 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
