A bill to amend 1975 PA 46, entitled

"An act to create the office of the legislative corrections ombudsman; to prescribe the powers and duties of the office, the ombudsman, the legislative council, and the department of corrections; and to provide remedies from administrative acts,"

by amending section 4 (MCL 4.354), as amended by 2018 PA 571, and by adding section 4a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) The ombudsman may commence an investigation upon
- 2 either of the following:

- 1 (a) Receipt of a complaint from a prisoner, a legislator, or
- 2 on the ombudsman's own initiative, concerning an administrative act
- 3 that is alleged to be contrary to law or contrary to departmental
- 4 policy.
- 5 (b) The ombudsman's own initiative for significant prisoner
- 6 health and safety issues, correctional facility security, and
- 7 public safety, and other matters for which there is no effective
- 8 administrative remedy.
- 9 (2) Subject to approval of the council, the ombudsman shall
- 10 establish procedures for receiving and processing complaints,
- 11 conducting investigations, holding hearings, and reporting the
- 12 findings resulting from the investigations.
- 13 (3) The ombudsman may consult with any of the following
- 14 individuals during an investigation under subsection (1) regarding
- 15 a physical or mental health issue:
- 16 (a) An individual who is licensed as a physician under part
- 17 170 or part 175 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL
- 18 333.17001 to 333.17097 and MCL 333.17501 to 333.17556.

- 26 Sec. 4a. The health audit division is created within the
- 27 office. The health audit division shall monitor the physical and
- 28 mental health of prisoners.
