refused admittance , or when into the premises to be searched.

10 (4) Subsections (1) and (2) do not apply if the breaking of an 11 outer or inner door or window of a house or building, or anything 12 therein, is necessary for a law enforcement officer to liberate 13 himself or herself or any person assisting him or her in execution 14 of the warrant from the premises subject to search.
