July 23, 2020, Introduced by Senators HORN, THEIS, MACGREGOR and SCHMIDT and referred to the Committee on Economic and Small Business Development.

A bill to amend 1974 PA 154, entitled "Michigan occupational safety and health act,"

(MCL 408.1001 to 408.1094) by adding section 85.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 85. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act,
- 2 and except as otherwise provided in subsection (2), an employer is
- 3 not liable for damages that result from the exposure of an employee
- 4 to COVID-19 if all of the following conditions are met:

- 1 (a) The employee was exposed to COVID-19 during the COVID-19 emergency.
- 3 (b) The employer was operating in substantial compliance or
- 4 reasonably consistent with a federal or state statute or
- 5 regulation, executive order, or public health guidance that was
- 6 relevant to, and applicable at the time of, the exposure. If more
- 7 than 1 public health guidance applied to the employer at the time
- 8 of the exposure, the requirements of this subdivision are satisfied
- 9 if the employer was operating in substantial compliance or
- 10 reasonably consistent with any applicable public health guidance.
- 11 (2) Subsection (1) does not apply if the employer wilfully
- 12 exposed the employee to COVID-19.
- 13 (3) This section does not do any of the following:
- 14 (a) Create, recognize, or ratify a claim or cause of action of
- 15 any kind.
- 16 (b) Eliminate a required element of a claim of any kind
- 17 including, but not limited to, a causation or proximate cause
- 18 element.
- 19 (c) Amend, repeal, alter, or affect any other immunity or
- 20 limitation of liability.
- 21 (4) This section applies retroactively to an exposure to
- 22 COVID-19 that occurs after January 1, 2020.
- 23 (5) As used in this section:
- 24 (a) "COVID-19" means the novel coronavirus identified as SARS-
- 25 CoV-2 or a virus mutating from SARS-CoV-2, the disease caused by
- 26 the novel coronavirus SARS-CoV-2, and conditions associated with
- 27 the disease.
- 28 (b) "COVID-19 emergency" means the state of emergency declared
- 29 under 1945 PA 302, MCL 10.31 to 10.33, or the emergency management

- act, 1976 PA 390, MCL 30.401 to 30.421, on March 10, 2020, and any subsequent orders or amendments to those orders.
- 3 (c) "Public health guidance" means written guidance related to
 4 COVID-19 issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention
 5 or the federal Occupational Safety and Health Administration, or by
 6 the department of health and human services or another agency of
 7 this state.
- 8 (d) "Wilful" means that term as defined in section 6.
