## **SENATE BILL NO. 1078**

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 642 (MCL 257.642), as amended by 2012 PA 498.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 642. (1) When—If a roadway has been—is divided into 2 or more clearly marked lanes for traffic, the following rules in addition to all others consistent with this act apply:

  - (ii) In preparation for a left turn, or where turn.

  - (d) (c) Official traffic control devices may be erected directing specified traffic to use a designated lane or designating those lanes to be used by traffic moving in a particular direction regardless of the center of the roadway, and operators of vehicles shall obey the directions of the traffic-control traffic control device.
  - (e) (d) Official traffic-control traffic control devices may be installed prohibiting the changing of lanes on sections of roadway, and operators of vehicles shall obey the directions of the traffic-control traffic control devices.
