September 15, 2020, Introduced by Senators ALEXANDER, SANTANA, BRINKS, WOJNO, CHANG, GEISS, MCCANN, BULLOCK, MCMORROW, POLEHANKI, BAYER, MOSS, IRWIN, ANANICH, JOHNSON and HOLLIER and referred to the Committee on Elections.
