A bill to amend 1988 PA 226, entitled

"An act to limit the powers of a local governmental unit regarding the leasing of private residential property,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 123.411), as amended by 2018 PA 585.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) As used in this section, "local governmental unit"
- 2 means a political subdivision of this state including, but not
- 3 limited to, a county, city, village, or township, if the political
- 4 subdivision provides local government services for residents in a

- 1 geographically limited area of this state as its primary purpose
  2 and has the power to act primarily on behalf of that area.
- 3 (2) Subject to subsections (3) and (4), and except as provided 4 under the rent limitation and specific tax authorization act, a 5 local governmental unit shall not enact, maintain, or enforce an 6 ordinance or resolution that would have the effect of controlling 7 the amount of rent charged for leasing private residential
- 8 property.
- 9 (3) This section does not impair the right of any local
  10 governmental unit to manage and control residential property in
  11 which the local governmental unit has a property interest.
- 12 (4) This section does not limit the power of a local
  13 governmental unit to adopt an ordinance or resolution to implement
  14 a plan to use voluntary incentives and agreements to increase the
  15 supply of moderate- or low-cost private residential property
  16 available for lease.
- 17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days 18 after the date it is enacted into law.
- Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect unless Senate Bill No. 1132 of the 100th Legislature is enacted into law.
