A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 21527 (MCL 333.21527), as amended by 2014 PA 320.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 21527. (1) If an individual alleges to a physician or
other member of the attending or admitting staff of a hospital that
within the preceding 120 hours the individual has been the victim

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- 1 of criminal sexual conduct under sections 520a to 520l of the
- 2 Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.520a to 750.520l, the
- 3 attending health care personnel responsible for examining or
- 4 treating the individual immediately shall inform the individual of
- 5 the availability of a sexual assault medical forensic examination,
- 6 including the administration of a sexual assault evidence kit. If
- 7 consented to by the individual, the attending health care personnel
- 8 shall perform or have performed on the individual the sexual
- 9 assault medical forensic examination, including the procedures
- 10 required by the sexual assault evidence kit. The attending health
- 11 care personnel shall also inform the individual of the provisions
- 12 for payment for the sexual assault medical forensic examination
- 13 under section 5a of 1976 PA 223, MCL 18.355a.
- 14 (2) An individual who is informed of the availability of a
- 15 sexual assault medical forensic examination under subsection (1)
- 16 and who is a victim of police sexual misconduct must be provided a
- 17 police sexual misconduct incident report form as provided under
- 18 section 6a of the sexual assault victim's access to justice act,
- 19 2014 PA 319, MCL 752.956a.
- 20 (3) (2)—As used in this section: , "sexual
- 21 (a) "Police sexual misconduct" means that term as defined in
- 22 section 2 of the sexual assault victim's access to justice act,
- 23 2014 PA 319, MCL 752.952.
- 24 (b) "Sexual assault evidence kit" means a standardized set of
- 25 equipment and written procedures approved by the department of
- 26 state police that have been designed to be administered to an
- 27 individual principally for the purpose of gathering evidence of
- 28 sexual conduct, which evidence is of the type offered in court by
- 29 the forensic science division of the department of state police for

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- 1 prosecuting a case of criminal sexual conduct under sections 520a
- $\mathbf{2}$ to 520l of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.520a to
- **3** 750.520*l*.
- 4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 5 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 6 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 7 unless Senate Bill No. 1164 of the 100th Legislature is enacted
- 8 into law.
