A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1280h.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1280h. (1) The superintendent of public instruction shall
- 2 appoint 5 members to an advisory committee within the department
- 3 that shall aid the department in developing or adopting and
- 4 updating the resource guide described in section 1280i(10). The
- 5 advisory committee must consist of the following 5 members:

- 1 (a) One member with experience working in the field of
 2 dyslexia intervention, as determined by the superintendent of
 3 public instruction, who is employed by the department or an entity
 4 that represents the interests of school board members or school
 5 administrators.
 - (b) One member from an institution of higher education with expertise in dyslexia screening and interventions, as determined by the superintendent of public instruction.
- 9 (c) Two members who are or have been employed by a school
 10 district, intermediate school district, or public school academy
 11 and who have expertise in dyslexia screening and interventions, as
 12 determined by the superintendent of public instruction.
- (d) One member that is an individual with a dyslexia diagnosis
 or is the parent of an individual with a dyslexia diagnosis.
- 15 (2) As used in this section, "dyslexia" means that term as 16 defined in section 1280i.

17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect 18 unless all of the following bills of the 100th Legislature are 19 enacted into law:
