THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. (1) A health care facility that has obtained written
- 2 consent to release sexual assault kit evidence shall notify the
- 3 investigating law enforcement agency, if known, or the law
- 4 enforcement agency having jurisdiction in that portion of the local
- 5 unit of government in which the medical facility is located of that
- 6 fact within 24 hours after obtaining that consent.

1 (2) A health care facility that has not obtained written 2 consent to release any sexual assault kit evidence shall inform the 3 individual from whom sexual assault kit evidence was obtained of 4 its sexual assault kit evidence storage policy. The information provided under this subsection shall must include a statement of 5 the period for which that evidence will be stored before it is 6 7 destroyed and how the individual can have the evidence released to 8 the investigating law enforcement agency at a later date. Any sexual assault kit evidence that is not released to a law 9 10 enforcement agency under this section shall must be stored for a 11 minimum of 1 year 2 years before it is destroyed.
