## **SENATE BILL NO. 1206**

A bill to amend 1978 PA 566, entitled

"An act to encourage the faithful performance of official duties by certain public officers and public employees; to prescribe standards of conduct for certain public officers and public employees; to prohibit the holding of incompatible public offices; and to provide certain judicial remedies,"

by amending the title and sections 1 and 2 (MCL 15.181 and 15.182).

## TITLE

- 6 (a) "Governing board" means a board of regents, board of
- 7 trustees, board of governors, board of control, or other governing
- 8 body of an institution of higher education.
- 9 (b) "Incompatible offices" means public offices held by a
- 10 public official which, when the official is performing the duties
- 11 of any of the public offices held by the official, results in any
- 12 of the following with respect to those offices held:
- 13 (i) The subordination of 1 public office to another.
- 14 (ii) The supervision of 1 public office by another.
- 15 (iii) A breach of duty of public office.
- (c) "Institution of higher education" means a college,
- 17 university, community college, or junior college described in
- 18 section 4, 5, or 6 of article 8 of the state constitution of 1963
- 19 or established under section 7 of article 8 of the state
- 20 constitution of 1963.
- 21 (d) "Public employee" means an employee of this state, an

- 1 appointed to any of the following:
- (i) An office established by the state constitution of 1963.
- $oldsymbol{3}$  (ii) A public office of a city, village, township, or county in  $oldsymbol{4}$  this state.
- 5 (iii) A department, board, agency, institution, commission,
- 6 authority, division, council, college, university, school district,
- 7 intermediate school district, special district, or other public
- 8 entity of this state or a city, village, township, or county in
- 9 this state.
- Sec. 2. (1) Except as provided in section 3, a public officer
- 11 or public employee shall not hold 2 or more incompatible offices at
- 12 the same time.
- 13 (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) and section 3, a public
- 14 officer or public employee shall not hold 2 or more elected offices
- 15 at the same time. As used in this subsection, elected office does
- 16 not include a precinct delegate.
