HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.20

Speaker Chatfield offered the following concurrent resolution: A concurrent resolution to create the Joint Select Committee 1 2 on the COVID-19 Pandemic. 3 Whereas, It is the inherent responsibility of the Legislature to oversee the operations of the executive branch and ensure the 4 effective implementation and operation of state government 5 programs. The Michigan Legislature passed the Emergency Management 6 7 Act in 1976 and other related laws to grant the Governor certain responsibilities for coping with dangers to this state and the 8 people of this state presented by a disaster or emergency; and 9 10 Whereas, On March 10, 2020, Governor Whitmer issued Executive Order 2020-04 declaring a state of emergency across the state of 11 12 Michigan to address the COVID-19 pandemic; and 13 Whereas, On April 1, 2020, Governor Whitmer issued Executive 14 Order 2020-33 to replace Executive Order 2020-04 and expand that

- 3 Whereas, On April 7, 2020, the Legislature extended the
- 4 declared states of emergency and disaster until April 30, 2020;
- 5 now, therefore, be it
- 6 Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate
- 7 concurring), That there be created the Joint Select Committee on
- 8 the COVID-19 Pandemic. The joint select committee shall consist of
- 9 five members of the House of Representatives appointed by the
- 10 Speaker of the House, two from the House Democratic Caucus
- 11 recommended by the House Minority Leader and three from the House
- 12 Republican Caucus, and five members of the Senate appointed by the
- 13 Senate Majority Leader, two from the Senate Democratic Caucus
- 14 recommended by the Senate Minority Leader and three from the Senate
- 15 Republican Caucus. The Speaker of the House shall designate the
- 16 chairperson of the joint select committee, and the Senate Majority
- 17 leader shall designate the vice chairperson; and be it further
- 18 Resolved, That, pursuant to MCL 4.541, the joint select
- 19 committee may subpoena and have produced before it the records and
- 20 files of any state department, board, institution or agency, and it
- 21 shall be the duty of any state department, board, institution or
- 22 agency to produce before the joint select committee as required by
- 23 the subpoena, or permit the members of the committee to inspect its
- 24 records and files; and be it further
- 25 Resolved, That the joint select committee shall examine the
- 26 status and efficacy of governmental actions in response to the
- 27 COVID-19 pandemic in Michigan. The joint select committee shall
- 28 report to the Legislature a summary of its findings and
- 29 conclusions, as well as any recommendations on further appropriate

- 1 actions the Legislature may take to address the COVID-19 pandemic
- 2 and to prevent or prepare for similar emergencies in the state.
